- All forms of mixed media, including photography, sketch, drawing, sculpture, street art, painting and computer designed artwork is accepted. However, artwork needs to be submitted as photograph image or in a jpeg format.
- Images of art should be in landscape format/direction.
- Entries must not include any business as the subject matter. Entries featuring people must obtain a signed talent release form (form available from Community Development Co-ordinator jill@wdcl.com.au).
- Entries must not be considered offensive. Be creative and the more local to Wentworth and surrounds, the better.
- Entries are to be submitted in jpeg format (minimum of 300dpi) on a disc or USB stick.
- Each person is allowed a maximum of two entries.
- Only fully completed and signed entries will be accepted.

Entries close 5pm on 31st October 2020.
